MODULES DESCRIPTION

INTRODUCTION TO NURSING AIDES

An introduction to becoming a Nursing Aide in the Healthcare Industry that comprises of, clinical services, healthcare-related support services and the roles of healthcare professionals in this industry. In addition, students need to understand that the primary goal of a Nursing Aide is to provide quality patient care, while strongly advocating a patient's individualized needs with empathy and communication skills.

FIRST AID CERTIFICATION FOR NURSING AIDES

The aim of this unit is to identify the underlying causes of different types of injuries, administer basic immediate first aid without any medical help, perform adult CPR and use the AED and learn foreign body airway obstruction (i.e. choking) management for a conscious or unconscious adult

BASIC HYGIENE AND BASIC INFECTION CONTROL FOR NURSING AIDES

Proficiency in comprehending and delivering training on the importance of maintaining proper hygiene for clients/patients is a fundamental aspect of ensuring safety within healthcare environments. This encompasses various aspects, including correct handwashing techniques, the use of protective gloves, safeguarding the well-being of clients/patients by maintaining their facial and bodily hygiene, and providing education on common infections prevalent in healthcare facilities to Nursing Aides.

PERSONAL AND DAILY CARE FOR ELDERLY FOR NURSING AIDES

Nursing Aides are trained to demonstrate skills in personal care such as assisting in dressing, bathing, assistance with meals and medication, while making a difference to the quality of life for the elderly. As Nursing Aide care is sensitive to the individual, Nursing Aides will be trained to be discreet and to take time to build a close rapport with their clients/patients to make sure it is a more individual and personal experience.

SELF-CARE FOR NURSING AIDES

An initial exploration of the concept of self-care is provided to Nursing Aides. As these professionals may experience physical and emotional exhaustion in the course of their duties, they may encounter a range of health issues, including stress and various physical ailments. Stress, in particular, is a prevalent concern that can lead to burnout, characterized by symptoms such as irritability, fatigue, sleep disturbances, weight fluctuations, feelings of helplessness or hopelessness, and social isolation. Aides will be equipped with coping strategies, which include fostering self-compassion, prioritizing nutrition and quality sleep, and maintaining social connections as essential aspects of self-care.

ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND DEMENTIA FOR NURSING AIDES

Awareness and understanding both diseases will provide Nursing Aides with additional support and assistance to work well with seniors. Seniors will be encouraged to be independent and to live a fulfilled life within their healthcare facilities. Nursing Aides will be trained to be competent in skills that will support Seniors with daily routine, and helping those with memory loss to remain independent. Nursing Aides will also be encouraged to show empathy and compassion with quality care using different strategies to support their patients.
