COURSE OVERVIEW

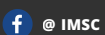

MODULES DESCRIPTION

INTRODUCTION TO RWAS AND GLOBAL TOKENIZATION MARKETS

This module covers the fundamental shift from traditional asset management to blockchain-based tokenization. Students explore asset types, regional market growth drivers, and the liquidity and transparency benefits of tokenization. The module provides context for the global RWA landscape with a focus on emerging markets in the Middle East, China, and Southeast Asia.

BLOCKCHAIN ARCHITECTURE AND INFRASTRUCTURE FOR RWAS

This module focuses on the technical distributed ledger technology (DLT) layers, consensus mechanisms, and institutional custody solutions required for secure asset issuance. Students evaluate blockchain infrastructure options and gain practical knowledge of wallet governance, gas fee models, and multi-party computation (MPC) security protocols.

RWA TOKEN STANDARDS AND SMART CONTRACT LOGIC

A technical deep-dive into fungible and non-fungible token standards, including advanced security token protocols such as ERC-1400. Students explore compliance-embedded smart contract logic, off-chain metadata integration, and real-world case studies from leading RWA platforms including Ondo Finance, Centrifuge, and PAXG.

LEGAL, REGULATORY, AND COMPLIANCE FRAMEWORKS

This module navigates global securities laws, Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) structures, and AML/KYC/CTF requirements for digital assets. Students analyze jurisdiction-specific regulations across Singapore (MAS), UAE (VARA/ADGM), and other key markets, and design multi-level compliance infrastructure including Travel Rule protocols for cross-border transfers.

TAXATION AND INTERNATIONAL STRUCTURING

This module examines the fiscal implications of token issuance, capital gains, and cross-border tax agreements as they apply to real-world asset tokenization. Students evaluate international holding structures, interpret Double-Taxation Agreements (DTAs), and analyze tax case studies for specific asset classes including precious metals and royalty tokens.

OPERATIONS, INFRASTRUCTURE, AND LIFE-CYCLE MANAGEMENT

This module covers the practical logistics of minting, vaulting, and maintaining the 'Oracle' link between physical and digital asset states. Students explore custody logistics, token minting workflows, oracle integration for real-time pricing, and liquidity model design for secondary markets including AMM and order book structures.

TOKENOMICS AND SUSTAINABLE ECONOMIC DESIGN

This module focuses on creating economic models that ensure long-term value, utility, and incentive alignment for RWA tokens. Students design yield-bearing mechanisms, formulate supply mechanics, establish NAV-based valuation methodologies, and evaluate Token Generation Event (TGE) management strategies to support sustainable market dynamics.

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MODULES DESCRIPTION

PLATFORM ARCHITECTURE AND TECH STACK INTEGRATION

This module covers the software engineering side of RWA platforms, focusing on portal design, decentralized exchange (DEX) integration, smart contract factory patterns, and API connections. Students design end-to-end platform architectures and evaluate integration strategies for legacy payment gateways, IoT, and analytics infrastructure.

MARKETING, BRANDING, AND COMMUNITY ECOSYSTEMS

This module covers strategies for building trust and attracting both institutional and retail capital to RWA offerings. Students develop compliant marketing frameworks, design Initial Asset Offering (IAO) playbooks, and create community engagement plans for platforms targeting high-net-worth individuals and professional investors across global jurisdictions.

TALENT, GOVERNANCE, AND ORGANIZATIONAL MANAGEMENT

This module focuses on building the human capital and governance structures required to operate a regulated blockchain business. Students explore team composition, technical talent assessment, DAO-lite governance design, cross-border team management, and intellectual property protection in blockchain venture contexts.

INDUSTRY DEEP DIVES (SPECIALIZED TRACK)

This module provides sector-specific analysis for high-value tokenizable assets ranging from precious metals and real estate to luxury collectibles, environmental tokens, and structured financial products. Students develop deep understanding of the unique operational, legal, and valuation challenges in each asset class.

CAPSTONE PROJECT – THE IAO LAUNCHPAD

The final summative module requires students to design and present a complete tokenization project from asset selection to public launch strategy. Integrating knowledge from all prior modules, students produce a professional whitepaper, investor pitch deck, tokenomics model, technical architecture, and a comprehensive 12-week go-to-market roadmap for their chosen real-world asset.
